#### International Hellenic University

- The International Hellenic University (IHU) was initially established by Law (No 3391/2005)
- IHU is based in Thessaloniki and comprises nine (9) Schools and thirty-four (34) Departments spread in eight cities in Northern Greece (Thessaloniki, Kavala, Serres, Drama, Katerini, Edessa, Kilkis, & Didymoteicho).
- The total number of students are approximately 50.000,
- administrative staff is around 300 employees and
- educational staff is more than 600 people in total.





#### International Hellenic University

Two of the Schools (School of Humanities, Social Sciences & Economics and the School of Science and Technology) of the IHU belong to the University Center of International Programmes of Studies (UCIPS) offering postgraduate programmes that are taught exclusively in English.

Our Department is also offering a Masters' programme in soft and digital skills

There are also many collaborations with universities and research centers in Greece and abroad while memoranda of cooperation have been signed with academic and social bodies, strengthening its position both in the Greek higher education sector and the European one.

#### Foundation of the Department

- The Department of Early Childhood Education & Care is part of the Faculty of Social Sciences of the IHU of Thessaloniki.
- The Department was founded in the fall semester of the academic year 1985-1986.





# About Thessaloniki

- Thessaloniki is the secondlargest city in Greece, and the capital of the geographic region of Macedonia.
- The city was founded in 315 BC by Cassander of Macedon, who named the city after his wife Thessalonike, daughter of Philip II of Macedon and sister of Alexander the Great.
- An important metropolis by the Roman period, Thessaloniki was the second largest and wealthiest city of the Byzantine Empire.

# Thessaloniki the best Erasmus+ international student destination for the year 2022.

- Thessaloniki is the first city to be named the best Erasmus+ destination for the year 2022. The city won an international competition, that took place through the Erasmus+ App, with cities participating from all over Europe.
- The award took place in the context of ESN's International Erasmus Generation Meeting, in Porto, in April 2022, with the presence of more than 800 students, institutions, members of the academic community and representatives from the European Commission and other institutions.
- The competition was about adding "tips" for each Erasmus+ student destination city, so that potential incoming students can access them through the application and their movement becomes easier.
- Thessaloniki emerged as the winning city with over 400 tips, more than any other city.

- There is a regular bus service that runs from the train station to the University.

# Department of Early Childhood Education & Care


- The Department's curriculum covers the subject of education and care of infants and preschool aged children (from birth to the age of compulsory education), while focuses on the support of their families.
